**The Inflation Reduction Act of 2022 extends
health insurance subsidies for three more years.
WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR YOU?**

- People on a low income, young people, and millions of other Americans who receive healthcare insurance under the Affordable Care Act receive subsidies that lower the cost of their insurance.
- These subsidies were set to expire this year unless Congress extended them.
- If the subsidies expired, millions would have lost this support and may not have been able to afford healthcare insurance anymore.
- But the just-passed Inflation Reduction Act protects the subsidies by extending them for three more years.
- This comes at a critical time when everyday Americans are trying to reduce their monthly expenses to deal with inflation.
- The subsidies help them reduce costs related to a critical need – healthcare.
